

Participant Expectations

Please read the information below regarding student guidelines, and demonstrate your agreement to these terms by marking the appropriate box on the online registration page. The guidelines listed ensure a safe environment in which the goals of Camp Crimson can be achieved more effectively.

- 1) **Illegal Substances:** Alcohol and drugs, which violate local, state, or federal laws are strictly forbidden. Participants who are under the influence of an illegal substance, who possess an illegal substance, or who provide an illegal substance to anyone will face appropriate sanctions.
- 2) **Damage or Loss:** Participants assume all financial responsibility for damage they cause to the property of the University. Damage may include replacement, clean-up and labor costs. When individual responsibility cannot be determined, students will assume collective responsibility.
- 3) **Smoking:** The University is a smoke-free environment. Smoking in housing, classrooms, or offices is not permitted in accordance with University policy.
- 4) **Weapons:** Dangerous weapons such as firearms and knives are strictly prohibited. The University Police will confiscate a weapon and investigate the participant who possesses it. The participant may face appropriate sanctions.
- 5) **Respect For Others:** The University of Oklahoma is a community that consists of people of different backgrounds and beliefs; participant conduct will not be disrespectful, or in violation of the rights of others.
- 6) **Attendance:** Participants are required to attend all camp activities. This includes overnight residence in the residence halls. Participants found not to be in attendance at camp activities will face appropriate sanctions, and parents or guardians will be contacted.

DISCIPLINE: Participants whose behavior does not fall within these guidelines will be subject to sanctions imposed by the Program Director. The sanctions may include a warning, consultation, referral of action to the appropriate legal authority, and in severe or repeated behavioral problems, dismissal from housing and Camp Crimson. Financial obligations arising from dismissal from the program are the responsibility of the participant and parents. Refunds will NOT be issued for any participant required to leave the camp.
