

Language Exam Information as of 6/28/02

- A. Advanced Standing Exam: See Sheila to set up an exam given by MLL&L professors.
- B. CLEP: student should call 325-1921 and make an appointment to take the CLEP. It gives college credit for French & German up to 16 hours, Spanish up to 13 hours.
- C. Education Major Proficiency Exam: Use the Placement Exam, given in KH 228.
- D. Foreign Language Requirement Approval for languages not taught at OU: The College of Business needs a special version of the form; Arts & Sciences & the other colleges use the version with a blank for entering the name of the college. See yellow "handout" folder for forms; see "dept. info." binder/exams (update on page 2 of this information sheet) for a list of OU faculty & staff who have tested for specific languages in the past. This does not award college credit, but does allow the student to study something else instead of the indicated number of hours of the language.
- E. Graduate Foreign Language Exam: Give student the application form, and see last 2 pages of **gradlang.who** file in the **wpdocs** directory for the procedures. This is a reading translation exam.
- F. International Relations (College of Business) language requirement: See 1/30/01 e-mail from Prof. Cohen. Either the ACTFL/ETS exam or an exam approved by MLL&L may be used, but the e-mail says speaking competence is required along with reading competence. Check with Dr. Madland.
- G. Placement Exam for French, German, Russian & Spanish: take the placement exam during the scheduled dates and times in the Language Learning Center, KH 228. The placement may be appealed to the appropriate Language Coordinator. This does not award college credit, but does allow the student to study something else instead of the indicated number of hours of the language.
- H. Placement for other languages which are taught at OU: contact the MLL&L section leader for that language. This does not award college credit, but does allow the student to study something else instead of the indicated number of hours of the language.
