Requirements for a minor in Medieval and Renaissance Studies - 2205B

Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level, and 6 hours from each of the three core areas, from the approved courses listed below. No more than 3 of the 18 hours may be earned in Independent Study courses (3990 or 4990). At least 6 hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by A&S standards, that is, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass. The following specific requirements must be met:

Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Medieval and Renaissance Studies program.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared and successfully completed, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
