Requirements for a minor in Russian - 1106A

General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in Russian, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. Note that introductory (RUSS 1115 and 1225) courses are not counted toward this total. The following specific requirements must be met:

1. RUSS 2113
2. RUSS 2323
3. 9 hours from the following Russian courses:
3073, 3423, 4153, 4163, 4313, 4613

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Russian program in the Modern Languages Department.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
