## Visiting Scholar Program



### 1 Purpose

To encourage collaboration between partner institutions and provide a special international education experience for KNU students.

### 2 Field

The visiting scholar should be specializing in a field related to KNU interests and will be hosted by the appropriate KNU department.

### 3 Teaching Commitment and Class

- The visiting scholar will be required to teach 1 three-credit course(45 hours of class contact) over a period of 4 weeks.
- The maximum class size is 50 but usually 20-30 students are taking the class. Summer school classes are undergraduate introductory level classes.
- In winter session, handout is preferred(textbook is not required).

### 4 Timing

2008 Winter session : from 1st Monday of January - for 4 weeks

2009 Summer session : from 4th Monday of June - for 4 weeks

### 5 Extending links

The visiting scholar will also be expected to explore further academic and research links with their host department.

## 6 Financial Arrangements

KNU will provide:

- Roundtrip airfare (economy class)
- Accommodation(nearby hotel) for 4 weeks (up to 30days)
- \$ 2,000 stipend
