The University of Oklahoma

President David L. Boren has announced that the University of Oklahoma will offer a scholarship to posthumously recognize military service members who died while serving on active duty. Specifically, the scholarship will benefit a spouse or child of a military service member killed in the line of duty.

The first award will be available in the 2009-10 academic year should there be an eligible candidate. This award guarantees that the full cost of tuition, fees, books and room & board costs is covered through a combination of federal, state, institutional, and any other grants and scholarships the student is eligible to receive. The award is renewable for a maximum of eight (8) consecutive semesters provided the recipient maintains eligibility.

To be eligible the student must:

- Be a spouse or child of a service person killed in the line of duty.
- Be a resident of Oklahoma.
- Be admitted as a degree seeking undergraduate, graduate or postgraduate student.
- Annually file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Attend the University of Oklahoma full time.
- Meet the University of Oklahoma financial aid academic standards of progress.

To be considered for this scholarship, eligible students must provide the following information prior to the first semester attending the University of Oklahoma:

- Completed Folds of Honor Scholarship Application.
- Official military documentation of the service member's status and loss of life while in active service.
- Proof of relationship to the service person.

In the event the University determines at some future time that it is no longer possible for the funds to be used as specified herein due to changes in the status of the war theaters, this scholarship will be reviewed to determine the future end date of students qualifying for the award.
