AFTER YOU HAVE BEEN ADMITTED TO OU:

HOUSING

Upon completion of your application for admission/scholarships and the separate housing application (and if you have paid your \$30 application fee), a link to the housing contract will be emailed to your OU email address in the weeks following your official acceptance to OU. *The earlier you complete your online housing contract along with submitting the enrollment commitment*, the better your chances of receiving the residence hall options you most want.* Final room assignments are mailed from Housing and Food Services mid-summer. SET UP YOUR E-MAIL ACCOUNT

Get connected to the University of Oklahoma's official e-mail system and online services provided by OU Information Technology (OU IT). Your ou.edu email address is the primary means of communication for scholarships, financial aid and other important campus notifications. To access your e-mail you must activate your OU Net Account – your key to OU's technology resources such as enrollment, grades, tuition payment, course management software and computer labs. To activate your account, go to account.ou.edu and click

IMPORTANT NOTE: *Your official OU Financial Aid Notification will be sent to your OU e-mail address only. Set up your account as soon as possible!*

SUBMIT ENROLLMENT COMMITMENT BY MAY 1.

Students admitted to OU as incoming freshmen for the Fall 2009 semester will be required to submit a \$250 enrollment commitment by May 1, 2009. This commitment will cover the student's housing advance payment and enrollment program fee and will be used to secure the student's place at OU. If the student becomes exempt from University housing, the housing portion of the commitment will be applied to academic charges in the first semester at OU. This enrollment commitment is fully refundable if requested in writing prior to May 1, 2009. Admitted students with financial need will be considered for deferment upon written request. ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT AND ENROLLMENT

Keep an eye on the mail in April for details about pre-enrollment for fall classes at OU. *Set your appointment as soon as you can and as early in the summer as you can to get the best choice of classes and times!* You will come to campus for advisement and enrollment through very personalized programs run by either University College or the OU Scholars Program. Your whole family is welcome.

FINALIZE ADMISSION

At the end of your senior year, request to have your high school mail your final, official transcript to OU's Office of Admissions — 1000 Asp Ave, Norman, OK 73019. The final, official transcript is necessary to finalize your academic records file at OU.

CAMP CRIMSON

Camp Crimson, OU's premier orientation camp, is held in late July every year. Camp Crimson is the best way for incoming freshmen to become a part of the Sooner family early. The voluntary experience introduces students to campus life by immersing them in a casual interactive setting packed full of OU traditions, energetic current students, dedicated faculty and staff and, of course, hundreds of fellow new Sooners. RESIDENCE HALL MOVE-IN/SOONER ORIENTATION WEEKEND

Residence hall move-in for most freshmen starts on the Thursday prior to fall classes beginning. During that same period of time OU hosts Sooner Orientation Weekend (SOW) to allow new students to get acquainted with the campus and the Norman community and to find out about services and programs offered at the University. Orientation activities include New Sooner Convocation for students and parents, find-your-classroom tours, information technology sessions, vendor booths, student services sessions, free movies, food, recreational events and much more! Admitted students will receive information about SOW by mail in the summer.

ATHLETICS TICKETS

Seating is limited for OU football games. Depending upon demand, a lottery may be held to determine which incoming students may purchase season tickets. Full-time students can log onto soonersports.com to request the purchase of football and/or men's basketball season tickets during move-in in August. The University of Oklahoma Athletics Department also sponsors other sports including: baseball, women's basketball, cross country, golf, gymnastics, soccer, softball, tennis, track and field, volleyball and wrestling.
