Who can apply?

Selection Process

All applications will be reviewed by the University Vice President for Student Affairs and Dean of Students, and others appointed to a selection committee. OU Financial Aid will be contacted to assess need.

Application Process

Applicants must complete the attached application and follow all guidelines.

Applications should be typewritten or computer generated on **plain white paper** and should be **three (3) pages total:**

- (1) Cover sheet – you may type directly onto the form provided with a typewriter or, if you choose to create your own please include the exact information requested.
- (2) One page resume – as outlined in the attached application guidelines.
- (3) Response to essay questions.
- (3) Copy (official or unofficial) of your transcripts.
