Eleanor Lottingville, PhD has her doctorate in psychology from the University of Oklahoma. She was in private practice for twelve years with a focus on trauma and disaster, along with individual, family and marital issues. She worked with the Edmond Post Office massacre in 1986 and has done debriefings for the Oklahoma City Fire Department, the Oklahoma City Police Department and for eleven years provided debriefing services around the state for the Department of Human Services in deaths of children in abuse and neglect cases. She was in charge of the death notification teams for the American Red Cross following the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building.
