

**COLLEGE OF LIBERAL STUDIES
GRADUATE FBINAA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

The College of Liberal Studies offers two (one in each fall and spring semester) FBINAA Achievement Scholarships annually in the amount of \$825 each for graduate students in a College of Liberal Studies program. The award is designed to acknowledge the academic achievement of CLS students in their degree programs. These scholarships are made possible by the generous contributions of CLS alumni. Students may receive this scholarship only once.

Deadline for submitting application is 5:00 p.m. on the following dates:

Fall: **September 15th** Spring: **February 15th**

****Applications will not be accepted after the deadline.**

Criteria: *Students must meet all criteria to be eligible for consideration.*

- Must be a graduate of the FBI National Academic Academy
- Must be currently working in a criminal justice field
- Must have completed at least 6 Liberal Studies (LSTD) hours in graduate program
- Must have a minimum 3.50 GPA in LSTD hours
- Enrolled in awarding semester

Required Application Materials: *Application should be 4-6 pages. Please collate and staple all required materials.*

1. Completed Graduate FBINAA Achievement Scholarship Application Form
2. 1500 words or three (3) pages typed, double-spaced essay
 - Write a review or critique of a play, movie, or book that you found relevant or meaningful to your criminal justice career. Explain how the work influenced or changed your thinking, and why. Refer to the *Writing Critiques Guide* for more information at:

3. Updated resume (1-2 pages)
 - There is no one correct resume format; however, your resume should include information about, but not limited to, the following categories that are applicable to you:
Education, Community Involvement, Extracurricular Activities, Work Experience/ Internships, Honors, Awards, and Scholarships, and Additional Pertinent Information
4. Two letters of recommendation (if not being sent directly to CLS from recommending persons)
 - Name of recommending persons should be included on the scholarship application form
5. Provide a copy of graduation certificate or diploma from FBINAA

Selection Process and Important Notes: The recipients are selected after the deadline by a committee comprised of faculty, staff, and students. ***All required application materials must be submitted by the deadline in order to be reviewed. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure all application materials have been received.***

Presentation of the Award: Scholarship applicants and recipients will be notified by e-mail or regular mail after the Scholarship and Awards Committee has reached a decision.
