


Since assuming the position of president and CEO in 1997, Donohue has built the Chamber into a lobbying and political force with expanded influence across the globe. Under his leadership, the Chamber has emerged as a major player in election politics, helping elect congressional pro-business candidates through financial support and voter activism and turnout generated through the Chamber's grassroots organization, VoteForBusiness.com.

Prior to his current post, Donohue served for 13 years as president and CEO of the American Trucking Association. Currently, he is a member of the President's Council on the 21st Century Workforce as well as the President's Advisory Committee for Trade Policy and Negotiations. He also is president of the Center for International Private Enterprise, a program of the National Endowment for Democracy dedicated to the development of market-oriented institutions around the world.

Donohue earned a bachelor's degree from St. John's University and a master's degree in business administration from Adelphi University. He also holds honorary doctorate degrees from Adelphi, St. John's and Marymount Universities. Donohue and his wife, Liz, live in Potomac, Maryland. They have three sons.
