## **NY Artist Feinstein to Lecture at FJJMA Feb. 25**

NORMAN – Her artwork has been reviewed in *Momenta Art*, *Art in America* and *The New York Times* to name a few. New York artist Rochelle Feinstein will visit the University of Oklahoma for a public lecture at 5 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 25, at the Fred Jones Jr. Museum of Art.

The School of Art and Art History at the University of Oklahoma will present the lecture in the downstairs Mary Eddy and Fred Jones Auditorium as part of the Capstone program.

According to Jane Abersold, curator of ceramics at the FJJMA and professor at the School of Art, Feinstein's public lecture will focus on her own work, which is "a mix of painterly painting, political statement and personal experience."

Feinstein has exhibited her works nationally and internationally and has been a professor of painting and printmaking at Yale University's School of Art since 1995.

The lecture is free with paid admission to the museum.

The Fred Jones Jr. Museum of Art is located in the OU Arts District on the corner of Elm Avenue and Boyd Street, at 555 Elm Ave., on the OU Norman campus.

Admission to the Fred Jones Jr. Museum of Art is free to OU students with a current student ID and museum association members, \$5 for adults, \$4 for seniors, \$3 for children 6 to 17 years of age, \$2 for OU faculty/staff, and free for children 5 and under.
