

GRADUATE STUDIES IN THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA SCHOOL OF DRAMA



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

The applicant must hold a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution with a “B” average in the last 60 credit hours of course work (based upon the semester system). Specific circumstances including the demonstration of exceptional talent and high expectation of success in the graduate program may be cause for granting of conditional admission in cases where the average is slightly below the requirement.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

- 1) Apply for admission to the Graduate College on the forms they provide.
- 2) Apply directly to the School of Drama on the form enclosed.
- 3) Send the appropriate supplementary materials (see below) to complete your application.
- 4) Arrange to have three letters of recommendation sent to the School of Drama.

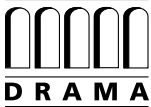
