Hemopathic viels ( $3 / 4 \times 3.5$ inches) are usod for exiori:montel work in which sincle pair matings are to be usod.

Medvedev, N.N. Culture bottles For individuel crossos and tosts we usc viels 80 x 20 mm in size.: In order to ret a lorge number of flies wo use a special kind of bottle, adopted in our Institute ovor two years ago. They are made of thick glass, preventinc the accidontal breadage of them. The size and dimonsion of this xind of bottle is given in the following figure.

The bottlo is made of the semo type of gless es milk botties, hes streieht sloping sides, tho inside top diameter is ebout $1 / 4$ inch less thon the inside bottom
