

LLOYD NOBLE CENTER FOOTBALL RV PARKING POLICIES

The following policies will apply to all RV parking at the Lloyd Noble Center parking lot on home football weekends. All policies are subject to change as deemed necessary by the University of Oklahoma.

1. **Parking permits are non-transferable.** Identification will be checked at entry. If the purchaser of the RV parking permit cannot be present, please obtain prior approval through the LNC Business Office by calling 405.325.4666 on M-F 8:00am- 5:00pm.
2. One vehicle, either a car or pickup, will be allowed to park with the RV. It may be parked in the space marked for the RV but it may not extend beyond the space allotted to the RV in any direction. Our attendants will be the sole arbitrators of whether a vehicle extends beyond the space. If it does not fit in the space, it must be parked east of the RV area. There will be no charge for one additional vehicle whether in the RV space or east of the RV area.
3. Friends and family may come in on Friday evening and must park in the area southeast of the RV parking. **They may not take their vehicles into the RV parking area.**
4. RV's may not arrive to park at this lot until 8am on Friday and must leave by 5pm on Sunday unless pre-arranged. Early arrivals are welcome and can be arranged through the LNC Business Office by calling 405.325.4666 on M-F 8:00am- 5:00pm.
5. **No hot ashes or coals may be dumped in trash containers or at the RV site.** **Please do not place ashes in trash containers.** Place ashes in dumpsters that are appropriately labeled for ashes and coals.
6. Overnight parking requires a permit or prior approval. Trucks, buses, and trailers must attain prior approval before parking overnight.
7. All pets must be kept on a leash when outside of RV. **Please clean up after your pet.**
8. **Speed limit is 10 mph in the RV parking area as well as the main parking lot.**
9. **Quiet time is from 11:00pm to 6:00am.** Please refrain from using generators during this time if at all possible and weather permits.
10. All state and local laws will be enforced at all times.
