EFFECTIVE DATE JULY 1, 1995: 47 O.S. § 15-112

A permanent insignia will expire five (5) years from the last day of the month in which the insignia was issued. Upon the expiration of a permanent insignia the insignia shall be returned to the Department of Public Safety. Renewal of an expired insignia needs to be recertified by taking a new application to your physician to be filled out and signed.

: In the event an insignia, whether permanent or temporary, is lost, stolen or destroyed, the person to whom such insignia was issued may apply in writing to the Department of Public Safety (Driver License Services, P.O. Box 11415, Oklahoma City, OK, 73136) for a replacement which will be issued with the same expiration date as the original insignia. Replacement fee \$2.00.
