OTHER PROGRAMS

- ◆ The Child Welfare Professional Enhancement Program, "CWPEP": offers students the opportunity to make a commitment to serve Oklahoma families and children at risk of abuse and/or neglect. Students accepted will receive monthly stipends or payment is made for tuition, certain fees and required textbooks. - ◆ Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and Related Disabilities Program, "LEND": a program designed to help students (**concentration year only**) pay for tuition and other expenses as well as train them in the field of children with disabilities and their families. LEND is a competitive *interdisciplinary training course* that students must apply for before entering. - ◆ Oklahoma Developmental Disability Council "ODDC": Each year, ODDC awards stipends to highly qualified students placed at agencies that provide programs and services to people with disabilities. Students will receive a stipend of \$2500 for working 240 hours and completing the required portfolio.
