

Graduate Research Assistantship/Studentship (GRA)

I am looking to fill a 12-month Graduate Research Assistantship/Studentship in the area of ecological genetics of arctic and temperate zooplankton, in my laboratory at The University of Oklahoma Biological Station (UOBS; <http://www.ou.edu/uobs>) with 2-year (24-month funding secured, with additional funding pending. Applicants must apply and be accepted into either the M.S. or Ph.D. Graduate Program in Zoology at the Univ. of Oklahoma (OU; <http://www.ou.edu/cas/zoology>), as well as fill out the necessary forms for Graduate School Admission at OU (<http://gradweb.ou.edu>). The initial monthly stipend will be ~\$1,600 (~\$20,000 per year), plus tuition waiver and health insurance coverage included. This GRA/studentship is available beginning 1 January 2008, although a later start date is possible.
