1. Present your position (state it as an answer to the questions associated with your topic)
2. Sketch an argument that supports your position. Think of an author you can draw on to help make your argument, and summarize one or two relevant passages from his work.
3. Exchange your work on 1 and 2 with a partner. On a separate sheet sketch an objection to your partner's position, making use of an author from the syllabus to help make this objection. When done, give your work to your partner.
4. On a separate sheet, sketch a response to the objection raised by your partner. Think of how the author you used in 2, or another author from the syllabus, could help make this response.
