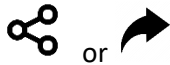


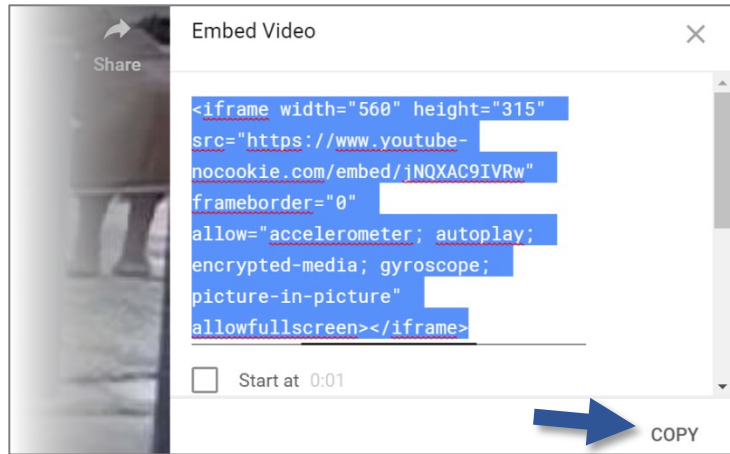
Using Embed Code in Canvas

COPY EMBED CODE

Locate and copy the embed code from the video you wish to share. Embed code is usually found by clicking the video's **Share** link, which is often represented by an icon:





Select and copy the *entire* embed code.

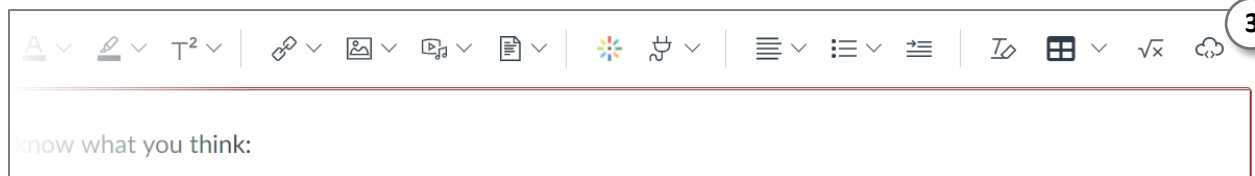


Shown above: YouTube Embed Code

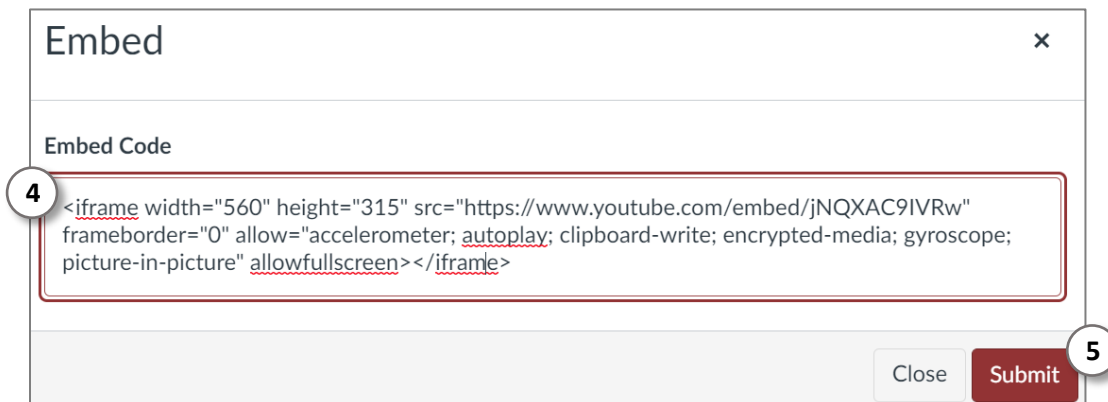
PASTE EMBED CODE IN CANVAS

1. Go to the page in Canvas where you want to use the embed code.
2. Place the cursor where you would like to insert the video.
3. Click the **Embed** button located at the right edge of the Rich Content Editor. 

You may need to click the three dots icon  at the right side of the Rich Content Editor to reveal the **Embed** button icon.









4. In the window that appears, paste the embed code you copied earlier into the box.
5. Click **Submit**.









6. Verify that the video has embedded correctly. You can add text before or after your video.
7. When you are ready, click **Save** or **Post Reply**.
