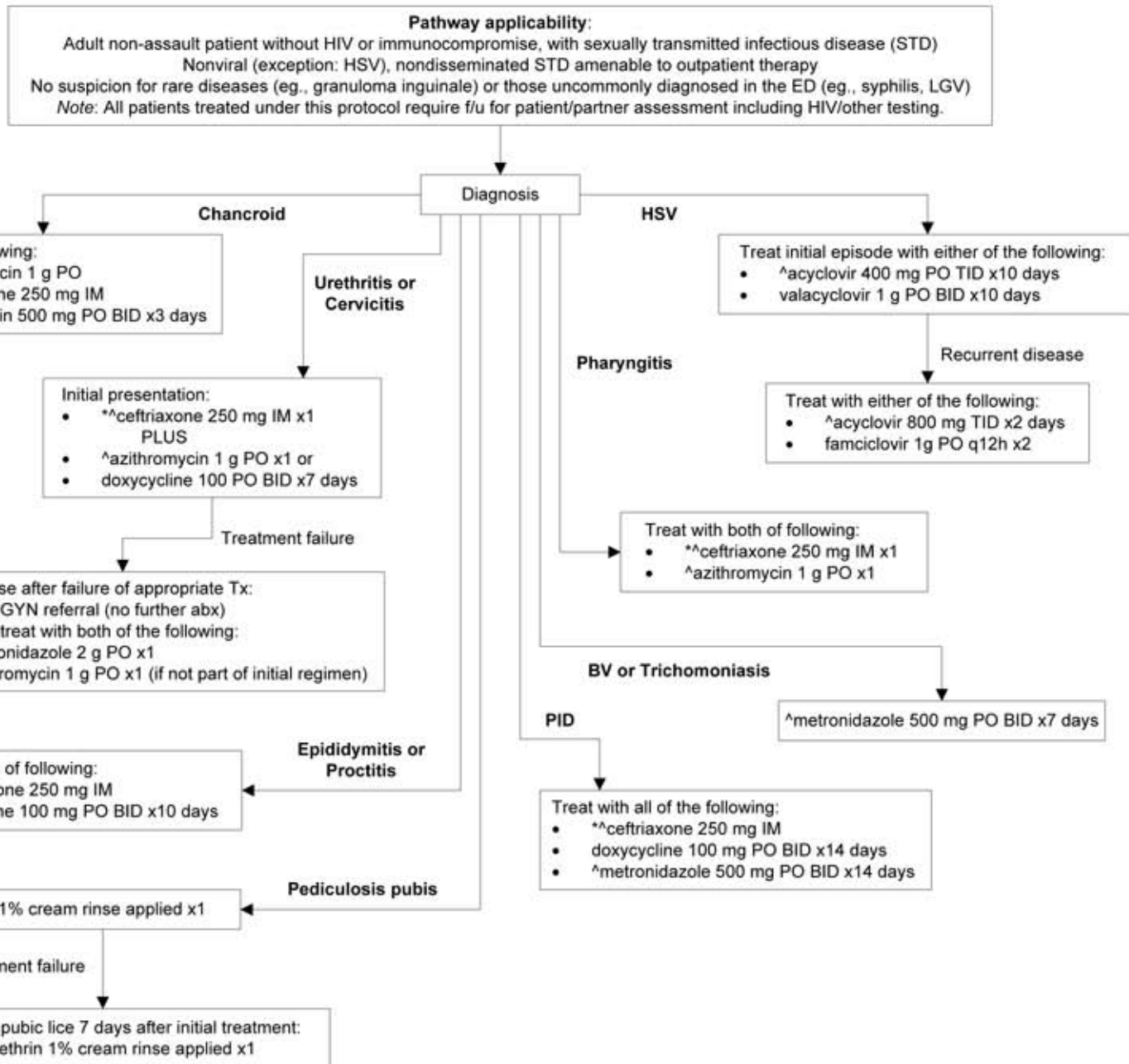

*For patients with reported penicillin allergy:
ceftriaxone contraindicated only if PCN allergy was severe (anaphylaxis, SJS, TEN)
azithromycin 2 g PO x1 is 2nd-choice GC Tx

^The following drugs are recommended/safe in pregnancy:
acyclovir
azithromycin
ceftriaxone
metronidazole
permethrin
