A Syrian school was bombed by two missiles; as a result most of the schools in this area have been closed/partially closed and are in need of help. MAX AMT APPROVED: \$412.33 2. Rho Chi requesting \$165 for lunch at a meeting. The meeting will be open to all students and the Rho Chi faculty advisor will be giving a presentation on study skills. MAX AMT APPROVED: \$100 3. Society of Urban Design Studies – student garden proposal. All landscaping must be approved by Mrs. Boren; proposal brought to OUTSA to gauge student interest – no money requested at this time. 4. Physician Assistants Program is requesting \$300 total for a fundraiser. The money will be used to buy drinks from Jamba Juice to sell in the student lounge. Funds raised will be used to 1) help support PA students to attend a conference in May and 2) to help fund PA philanthropy projects (Crafts with Kids at the Children's Hospital, HUGS, etc.). While some funds will be used to help cover the cost of travel for PA students attending the conference, PA currently has
