

OU-Tulsa Scholarship

Fall 2020 application for Spring 2021 funds

The OU-Tulsa Scholarship Fund was established to assist all students attending the OU-Tulsa Schusterman Campus with the costs of a college education. The total amount of scholarships awarded for this application period will be \$3,500. The planned distribution of scholarships will be: one \$1,250, one \$1,000, one \$750, and one \$500 scholarship. These scholarships will be credited toward **Spring 2021** bursar balances for the four selected recipients; selections are made based on quality of applicants’ essay responses and those who meet the requirements outlined in bullet points below.

Completed applications must be postmarked or delivered to the OU-Tulsa Student Affairs Office, Room 1C76 or emailed to Lauren Condry at lcondry@ou.edu by **Wednesday, October 21 at 5:00pm**. Applications received after this time will not be considered. *If selected as a scholarship recipient, the aid will not be disbursed to your bursar account until the start of the Spring 2021 semester.* **Please read the instructions carefully. Only applications that meet all of the following requirements will be considered; incomplete applications will not be reviewed by the selection committee.**

- Currently enrolled, degree seeking student at OU-Tulsa (full-time & part-time students are eligible)
- Enrolled in Fall 2020 & Spring 2021 semesters
- Making satisfactory progress toward graduation
- Transcript indicating a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA at OU-Tulsa:
 - If have completed at least one semester at OU-Tulsa, please provide an official OU-Tulsa transcript
 - If have not completed a semester at OU-Tulsa, please provide your official transcript(s) from your most recent college or university.

Immediate family members or direct contributors to this scholarship fund are not eligible for participation.
