PACE awards encourage excellence among students by honoring the top 1% of the fall 2013 entering freshman class based on the following criteria:

- Minimum 3.25 OU g.p.a. with preference given to applicants who completed 14 credit hours in fall 2013;
- Evidence of participation in campus activities and events for fall 2013;
- Evidence of community service during fall 2013; and,
- Evidence of leadership roles during fall 2013.

Faculty, staff, and students are encouraged to nominate outstanding students for this honor. Applications must be submitted at http://www.ou.edu/content/ univcoll/ honors awards.html#pace.

Applications must be submitted by 4:00pm on Friday, February 28, 2014. Applications should be as thorough as possible when documenting the applicants qualifications for the award. As always, the selection committee will look for students

who show evidence of participation in *each* category. Participation must have occurred between August 19 and December 13, 2013 only!

PACE winners will receive their award at the awards presentation on March 29, 2014 during Parents' Weekend. Those who nominate award winners will be invited to the awards presentation to share the excitement with the winners and their guests.




