The following are some basic style guidelines to follow when preparing your paper:

*Papers should be single spaced and left-aligned.

*There is no predefined page limit, though we expect most contributions will not exceed 25 pages.

*Font: 12 pt. Times New Roman for text and subheadings.

*Margins: 1" all around.

*Numbering: leave pages unnumbered.

*Use a single space after all punctuation, not two spaces.

*The first page of the article will include the heading, abstract, keywords, and then the beginning of the article.

*The heading should be formatted as follows:

Title (bold and centered, 14 point)

[skip a line]

Name (centered)

[skip a line]

Affiliation (centered)

* Abstract of about 100-200 words and a list of 5-7 keywords (place after the abstract: Keywords: $X, Y \dots$).

*Subheadings should be flush left. Subheading 1: bold. Subheading 2: italic. Subheading 3: same as normal text. Do not go below subheading 3.

*Use endnotes, not footnotes.
