
## Student Spotlight:

## Faculty Spotlight:

## Meet Marilyn Byrd, Ph.D.!



The Academy of Human Resource Development has named one of its annual awards in honor of Marilyn Byrd, Ph.D. The award, The Marilyn Y. Byrd Excellence in HRD Research-to-Practice Award, will be presented annually and will recognize publications in *Advances in Developing Human Resources*, which make significant contributions to human resource development theory and practice.

Byrd is the first sitting editor-in-chief to receive this honor in the 25+ years of AHRD's history. She is also the first Black American editor-in-chief of any of AHRD's four journals. In 2019, Byrd received the Critical HRD Scholar Award honoring a scholar whose research actively challenges normative views while advancing important critical perspectives and principles. She recently led Advances in Developing Human Resources through a major structural change that made significant improvements to the journal's submission process and system. Her vision is to move Advances into a competitive market as a leader in the research and practice of human resource development.

Marilyn Byrd is an associate professor with the Human Relations Department. She teaches Human Resources courses in the graduate program and advises the Student Society for Human Relations.
