# **GUIDELINES**

## Eligibility:

- Papers submitted cannot be previously published or submitted for publication.
- Papers must have been written in the previous twelve months.
- Papers must be in English, and must be the original work of the contestant.

#### Content:

 Papers can address any topic related to libraries, librarianship, or information management in libraries.

#### Format:

 The paper must be at least 10 pages, double-spaced, and include an abstract and bibliography. Papers should be submitted in MS Word with a completed coversheet.

## Copyright and Publication:

• By entering the contest, entrants grant permission to publish all or part of their paper's abstract and to use their name and photograph without royalty or other consideration.

#### Due Date:

 Papers should be submitted by e-mail to the Chair of the committee by February 18th, 2025. Notification of the winning paper will be made by March 7th.

## Judging Criteria:

- Topic relevancy, and appeal to professional librarians
- Organization
- Development of topic
- Authority evidence of scholarly research
