Felgar Society funds support renovations in key student laboratories and learning spaces.

MEMBERSHIP

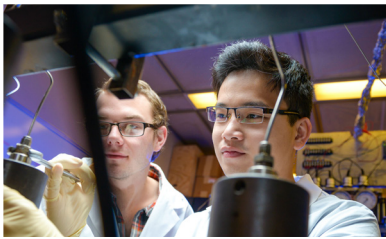
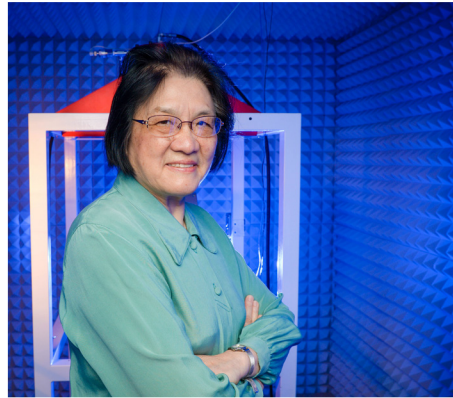
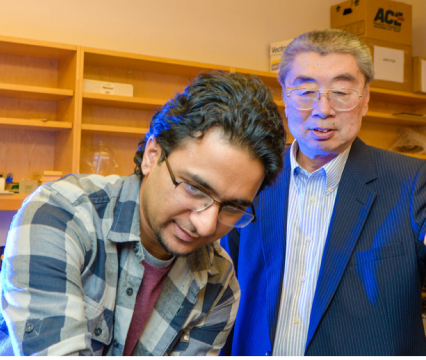

**Ages 39 and under qualify at \$2,500 annually for five years.*

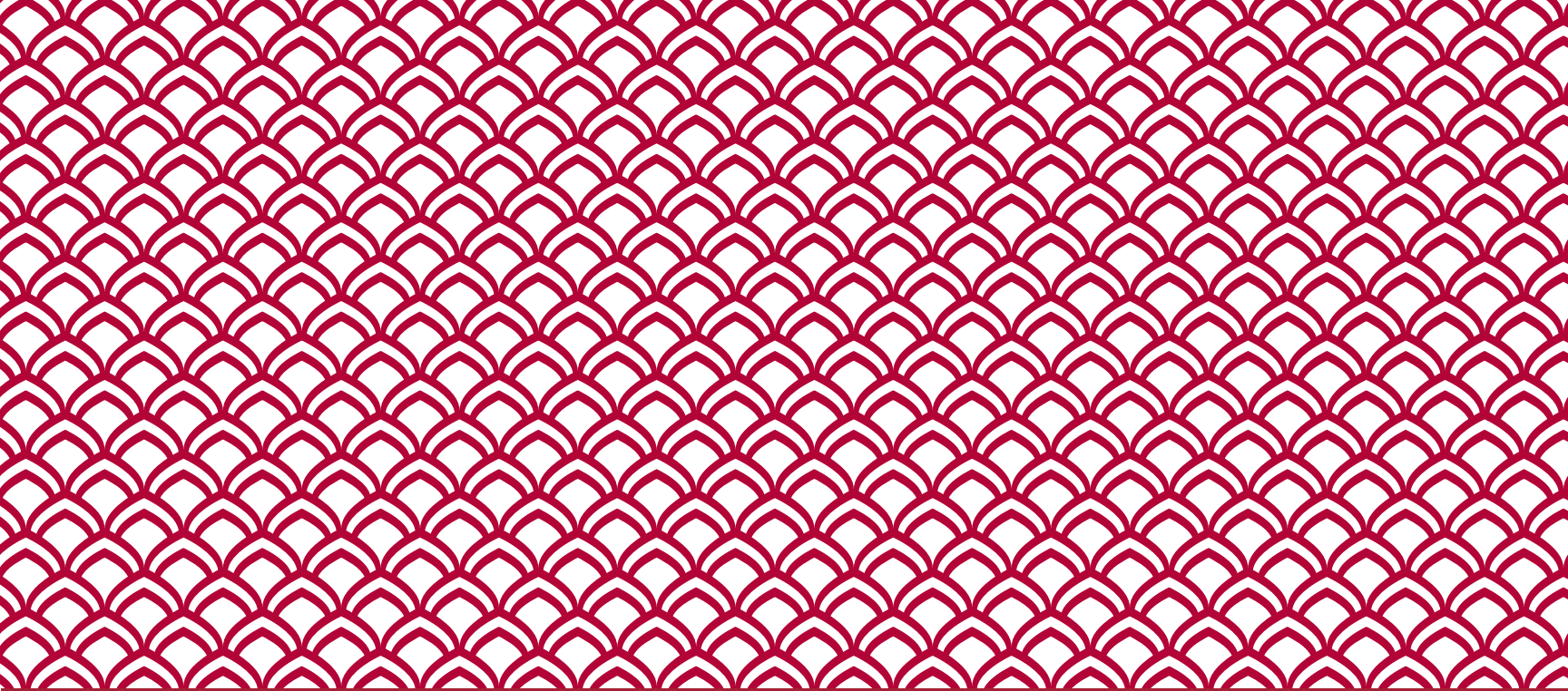
