Ms. Reid has served as the Executive Director of the NCSE since 2014. She spent the fifteen years prior working as a research biologist at the Armed Forces Institute of Pathology, where her efforts resulted in the sequencing of the 1918 flu virus. She has also served as director of the American Academy of Microbiology. Among other topics, she lectures on the impacts that societal controversies over climate change and evolution have in the classroom and is an advocate for maintaining integrity in the science classroom.
