Effects of Child Development Associate Credential 2.0 on Candidate Success Rates Committee Chair, Dr. Sarah Pratt

This mixed method study was conducted by reviewing national scholarship data and conducting interviews with credential seekers in order to understand the effects that changes to the Child Development Associate credentialing system had on candidates. The study revealed that candidate success rates increased with the new policy and system changes and identified factors that aided to candidate success. The implications of the study will allow for more informed decisions for potential credential seekers, early childhood centers seeking professional development, and public policy involving the ongoing development of the early childhood workforce.
