Child Care Subsidy and Wrap-Around Services Available

Who Is Eligible?

- **Undergraduate students who are eligible for Pell Grants**, or qualify for other public assistance (Graduate students who qualify for public assistance may be considered when the spot is not filled)
- Parent (including an expecting parent) or legal guardian of a child/children enrolled in the Institute of Child Development at OU (ICD, on-campus early care and education program) or other types of group care
- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- Have a child or children ranging in age from before birth -5th grade
- Are enrolled in a degree or certificate program at OU Norman or OU-Tulsa including online programs.
- Has a 2.0 GPA or higher
- Full-time students will have a priority
- Education majors will have a priority.

→ Purpose of the Program

- Faculty in the Jeannine Rainbolt College of Education received a grant from the U.S. Department of Education (2022-26) to support students' success and retention.
- The recipient will receive a child care subsidy (e.g., full or partial tuition coverage for ICD, after-school, and/or summer camp) and academic, student and family services through OU and community partnerships
