Master of Education (M.Ed.) Educational Administration, Curriculum and Supervision Moore Public Schools Master's Cohort Spring 2024

OVERVIEW

The University of Oklahoma, in collaboration with Moore Public Schools, is offering a Master of Education in Educational Administration, Curriculum and Supervision (EACS) degree that includes endorsement for principal certification in Oklahoma. Coursework is delivered over two academic years, with primary content delivered face to face and online coupled with real time classes meeting for a two-week extended period during the summer sessions. Classes will be held at a Moore Public Schools designated facility. The program is NOT restricted to Moore Public Schools employees.

The cohort will commence spring semester, 2024. The deadline for submission of application materials is January 5, 2024.
