RENTAL ASSISTANCE WILL BE CONSIDERED ONLY IN CASES OF EXTREME EMERGENCY. **Students are eligible to receive up to \$1,200 per academic year, with a lifetime maximum of \$4,800 during their enrollment.**

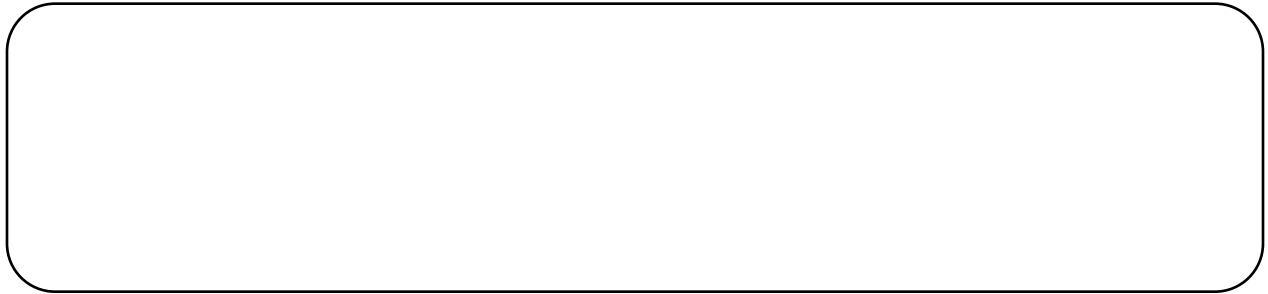

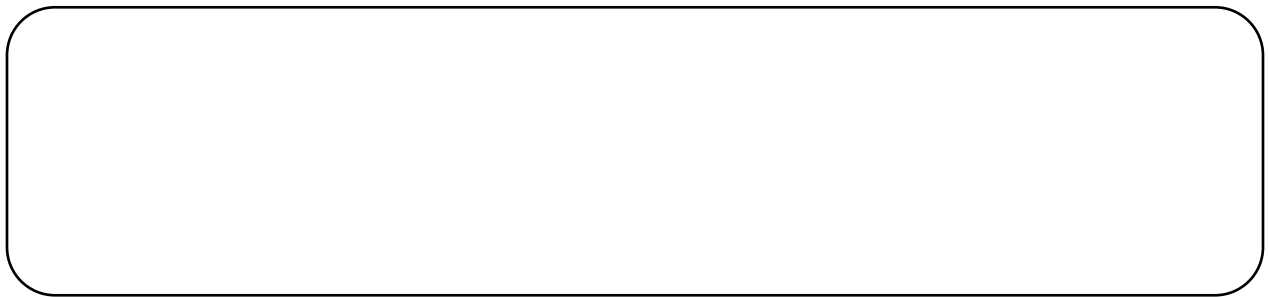
