COURSEWORK REQUIREMENTS

☐ Master's degree or equivalent 32 hours

Core Coursework

☐ ORGN 6020 Applied Doctoral Organ for Performance Majors 16 hours
No more than the required 16 hours may be applied to the degree.

☐ Musicology/Music Literature 6 hours
No coursework taken to remediate deficiencies in Musicology determined by the student's score on the Preliminary Exam may be used to fulfill this requirement. It may, however, be used as elective credit, providing it is at the 5000 or 6000 level.

The following is required if not taken during the master's degree:

☐ MUTE 5423 History and Fundamentals of Pipe Organ Construction and Design 0-3 hours

☐ Music Theory (excluding MUTH 5811, MUTH 5821, and Music Technology courses) 9 hours

☐ Enrollment in three semesters, as advised, of:

GDMA 6042 Graduate Recital – Doctor of Musical Arts Degree, and/or

LDMA 6052 Graduate Lecture/Chamber Recital – Doctor of Musical Arts Degree 6 hours

The following three courses are required if not taken during the master's degree:

☐ MULI 5453 Organ Literature I: Renaissance and Baroque 0-3 hours

☐ MULI 5463 Organ Literature II: 1750-1900 0-3 hours

☐ MULI 5473 Organ Literature III: 1900-Present 0-3 hours

☐ Electives 3-15 hours
With approval of program advisor and graduate liaison, may be chosen from any area as long as the course is at the 5000 level or above.
