Required Qualifications

 Masters degree in music and a record of successful teaching at the secondary and/or university levels with an emphasis on the specific skills required to successfully teach and administer a highly-visible and successful marching percussion program and to collaborate in a comprehensive percussion program that also includes basketball pep bands and concert bands

Desired Qualifications

- Demonstrated exemplary marching percussion arranging skills.
- Demonstrated ability to effectively collaborate with instructors and engage with students, and ability to promote teamwork and self-discipline
- Excellent problem-solving skills and attention to detail
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience supervising and planning the work of team members (this position also supervises and mentors graduate assistants).
- We are especially interested in candidates who will help cultivate a collaborative atmosphere
 within our band program and who can contribute, through their teaching, performing, and service,
 to the excellence of the academic community and who will work to build relationships with other
 departments within the College and the University.

Responsibilities

- This position is responsible for coordinating the preparation and ongoing musical development
 of all percussionists within the context of University Bands, including the Pride of Oklahoma
 Drumline (includes both battery and front ensemble instrumentation), the Sound of the
 Sooners Basketball Band, and the percussion sections within all concert ensembles.
- Additional teaching opportunities may include: applied non-major lessons, applied major lessons, and other teaching opportunities within the OU Percussion Studio and/or School of Music, depending upon the needs of the studio and School and the expertise of the candidate.

- Deliver instruction and supervision at all scheduled rehearsals, performances, and other services (including weekends, summer, and holidays as required.)
- Travel as needed with the bands as dictated by athletic and School of Music appearances nationally.
- Supervise and mentor percussion graduate assistants.
- Oversee the management and maintenance of the Band Area percussion inventory.
- Coordinate the annual Pride of Oklahoma Percussion Audition process
- Recruit outstanding percussionists to audition for and participate in the University of Oklahoma we Bands.
