Once you are admitted to the graduate portion of the ADP, you must meet all requirements and deadlines for the master's degree outlined in the <u>Graduate College Bulletin</u>, such as submitting a <u>Program of Study</u> and applying for graduation.

## Eligibility for graduate admission:

- During the final semester of your bachelor's degree, you will need to submit the online <u>Addition or Change</u>
   of <u>Program</u> form to apply for admission to the graduate portion of the ADP.
- You must meet the Graduate College admission criteria outlined in the <u>Graduate College Bulletin</u> to be eligible for admission to the graduate portion of the ADP. No exceptions will be made and conditional admission will not be permitted.

### <u>Grade point average (GPA) requirements:</u>

- Your GPA will be monitored by your undergraduate college until you have completed the bachelor's degree. If your undergraduate GPA, graduate GPA and/or overall GPA fall below a 3.00, you will be removed from the ADP and readmission to the ADP will not be permitted.
- Once you are admitted to the graduate portion of the ADP, your GPA will be monitored by the Graduate
  College. If your graduate GPA and/or overall GPA fall below a 3.00, you will be removed from the ADP.
  Neither academic probation nor readmission to the ADP will be permitted. You may apply to the standalone master's degree program, but you may not share hours (see the <u>Graduate College Bulletin</u> for rules
  on master's degree credit taken before graduate admission).
- The GPAs reported on your transcript may not reflect the GPA calculation methods used to determine your academic standing.
