TOOLS of RESEARCH

COURSEWORK REQUIREMENTS

Independent Research Course Limitations: Maximum of 6 hours with one instructor, but not more than 12 hours combined under one course number.

Required Courses

P BIO 5971 Seminar in Botany..... 3 hours
2 hours of P BIO 5971 taken for the master’s degree may be applied.

Outside Courses..... 6 hours
Credit hours of non-plant biology coursework as approved by the dissertation advisory committee.
Microbiology courses may be used as long as they are not cross-listed with Plant Biology.

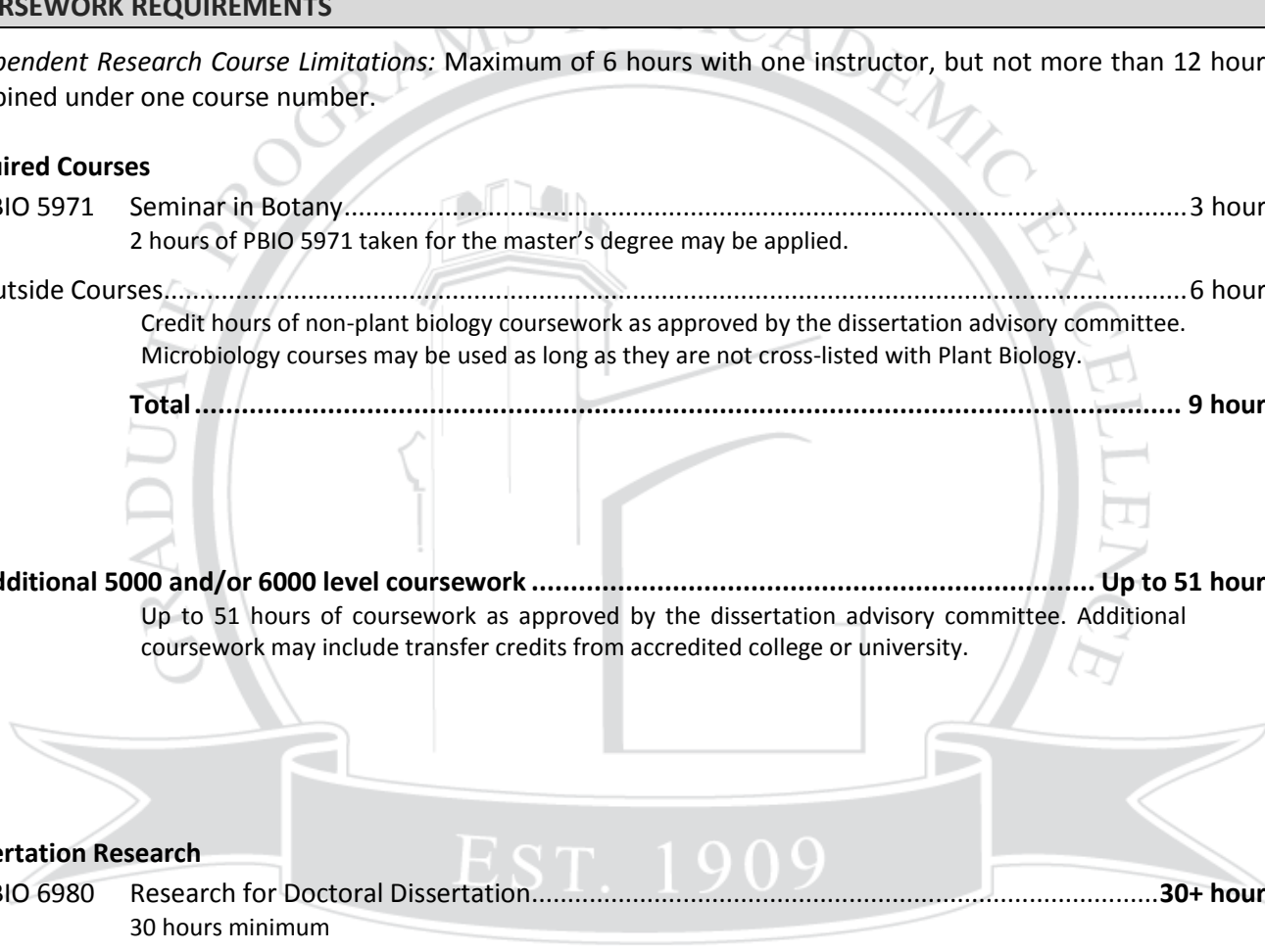
Total..... **9 hours**
