Notes: 1) While International (nonresident alien) students also answer the two race/ethnicity questions, their answers are excluded from this area of reporting due to federal guidelines.

2) The US Department of Education's IPEDS system gathers enrollment information in a way that requires each student to be in a single race/ethnicity category to prevent a student being counted multiple times and inflating enrollment figures. To accommodate those students who picked more than one race/ethnicity, they are show in official reporting counts in the "Two or More Races" category rather than in each individual category selected.
