### **Sales Force (Chris Jones)**

- Salesforce: Customer Relationship Management (CRM) system used to track information about individuals at OU
- For Norman undergrads, Slate is still used for this purpose
- So far, individual groups have been responsible for setting up Salesforce for their own purposes
  - Have each been engaging 3rd parties to do this and to do the support
  - IT is trying to build this capability at OU (to supplant the 3rd parties)
  - Have ½ FTE from Salesforce to advise on these processes
  - CRM governance committee to help advise, too
- Event Management
  - Multiple solutions being used across the OU campuses
  - Want to move toward EventBright for everyone
  - Edward: what services are being integrated?
    - Admissions, recruiting, event services, student success, marketing
  - EventBright is also available to faculty

### **Research Computing (Henry Neeman)**

- New supercomputer
  - Deploying first components now
  - Expecting to be in “friendly user” mode by Fall (as opposed to “user friendly”)
  - Existing hardware from Sooner will move gradually over to the new system and be in service until 2024
  - In parallel, new components will be purchased annually
  - Have some A100 GPUs (Nvidia) & will continue to add these
  - Burst buffer flash disk:
    - Before job execution, files will be migrated from slow storage to this burst buffer, allowing for better use of the processors
    - Bring up during summer 2021
- Working on OURCloud hardware and software refresh
- Research storage

- Model: research groups purchase media. OU IT covers maintenance, power, cooling
- OUrDisk:
  - Full production during summer 2021
  - Purchase in units of \$1000/slice (10TB)
  - Fast access within the data center
  - Mirror is possible with HSC (this doubles the costs)
  - Can mount onto other research systems (e.g., with NFS)
- OUrStore: tape archiving system
  - Replacement for PetaStore
  - Capacity: 100 Petabytes
  - Expecting cost of \$6/TB
  - Available to other EPSCOR institutions
- HIPAA-compliant storage
  - Expecting to be available late 2021 or early 2022
  - Only accessible within OU
- Aaron: will the chip shortage affect deployment?
  - No
- HIPAA compute/storage area
  - Will require accounts separate from those in the public area
  - Individual users responsible for managing the proper copying/management of data
- Computing purchases through Amazon
  - Even small, embedded processors are being flagged as needing review (and being delayed)
  - Can we add a prompt at Amazon that asks if the funding source is external?
    - Already have a comment section available during purchase

#### **IT Policy Updates (April Dickson):**

- April will attend these monthly meetings so we can be kept up to date & provide feedback
- Information classification standard: open for comments
- End user device security policies: open for comments
- Independent briefing this coming Monday @10 am
- Holding virtual office hours every 3rd Thursday of the Month 10-11am (Zoom) starting in May

#### **Security (Aaron Baillio)**

- Phishing:
  - Primary path that non-OU actors gain access to our systems
  - OU credential are being sold on the black market
  - Phishing susceptibility ("phish-prone rate")
    - Background rate: 4.3%

- OU is 3x higher
- OU sending fake phishing messages
  - Responding to these will result in training requirements
  - HSC and Tulsa have had this process for the last 1-2 years
  - Rolling out to faculty and students at OU-Norman soon
  - Just purchased a license for knowbe4
  - ITC supports this process
- Remote desktop
  - Requires VPN to use
- Carbon black / Crowd strike: will follow up later
