What is Degree Candidacy?

Degree Candidacy is the first step for students that have been admitted to Price College to begin upper-division business courses. Degree Candidacy requires a high level of academic performance. Listed below are the criteria. In addition to achieving Degree Candidacy, students must complete all prerequisite courses before beginning 3000-level business classes.

DEGREE CANDIDACY

- Must be a declared business major
A 2.75 OU and Combined Overall Retention GPA is required to declare a business major
- Must have an overall OU 2.50 GPA or higher
- Must have an overall Combined 2.50 GPA or higher
- Must have a 3.00 cumulative GPA in these courses:

ECON 1113 Principles of Economics - Macro

ECON 1123 Principles of Economics - Micro

ECON 2843 Elements of Statistics

All attempts (cumulative GPAs) are used.

Students must repeat any D's or F's in the Degree Candidacy courses.

University policy forbids students to repeat courses in which an A or a B is earned.

HOW TO APPLY

- Apply for Degree Candidacy in the semester you are taking your last Degree Candidacy course(s)

PREREQUISITES

Students must also complete the following prerequisites to enroll in upper-division business courses:

- ENGL 1113 English Composition I
- ENGL/EXPO 1213 English Composition II or Expository Writing
- MATH 1743 Calculus I for Business, Life, and Social Science
- B AD 1001 PC Productivity Tools

- Must maintain overall OU 2.50 GPA
- Must maintain overall Combined 2.50 GPA
