- 1. Go to <a href="https://facultyportal.com">https://facultyportal.com</a>.
- 2. Login with your OUNet ID single sign on.
- 3. Enter your adoptions.

For instructions on how to use Faculty Portal, you can email <u>oubookstore@textbookbrokers.com</u> and ask for help/instructions.

Textbook Brokers desires to make this easier for you, and they understand that you may not have adopted materials because you are not requiring anything to be purchased.
