

How to Become an Air Force ROTC Cadet at Det 675



<u>Eligibility:</u> To enroll in Air Force ROTC, you must be a full-time undergraduate student at OU or one of our crosstown schools and have a CGPA of 2.0 or greater (for any previous college coursework). You must be able to complete your undergraduate studies and commission before age 31 (up to age 35 with a waiver - restricted to high quality cadets). You must be of good moral character and in good physical condition, and be a US citizen or in pursuit of US citizenship.

How to Enroll:

- **OU students** can enroll in Air Force ROTC classes at normal enrollment times.

- Crosstown students will first need to apply to OU as an Undergraduate Visitor.
 - Go to http://www.ou.edu/content/admissions/apply/nondegree.html.
 - Scroll down to 'Undergraduate Visitors' and click 'Apply Now.'
 - Pay \$50 application fee, complete and submit application.
 - Crosstown students will also have to submit an official transcript or letter of good standing from their crosstown school. If it will be your first semester in college, you will need to submit your acceptance letter from your crosstown school and/or a printout of your schedule showing your name and hours enrolled.
 - Please refer any questions about the OU admissions process to the OU Office of Admissions at 405-325-2151.
 - Once you are admitted to OU, you can enroll in the Air Force ROTC classes.
- A freshman who is joining in the Fall should enroll in AERO 1011 and AERO 1300.
- A freshman who is joining in the Spring should enroll in AERO 1021 and AERO 1300.
- A **sophomore** who is joining in the Fall should enroll in AERO 1011, AERO 2011, & AERO 1300.
