SUBJECT: In- State Status of Members of ROTC

- 1. Oklahoma Senate Bill 138 was signed into law by the Governor on 21 April 2015 and became effective on 1 July 2015. Section 3247 of the Senate Bill 138 state the following:
 - a. "A student shall be eligible for in-state status regardless of the residency of the student if the student is a person who is ... participating in or has received a partial of full scholarship from the Air Force Reserve Officers' Training Corps, Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps or the Navy/Marines Reserve Officers' Training Corps."
 - b. "To be eligible for in-state status [as provided above] ... and to maintain eligibility, the student shall satisfy admission and retention standards as determined by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education for an institution within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education; and have secured admission to and enrolls full-time in a program of study at an institution within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education"
- 2. If you are enrolled at OU in a program of study (this excludes crosstown cadets who are enrolled as non-degree seeking students), then your enrollment/participation in the Air Force ROTC program at the University of Oklahoma qualifies you for in-state status. Your eligibility for in-state status will remain in effect as long as you are an active member of AFROTC. If you voluntarily withdraw from the program or are involuntarily let-dropped or disenrolled from AFROTC, the Det. 675 Pay Monitor will notify the OU Officer of Admissions and your in-state status will revert to out-of-state status.
