Bad actors are calling OUIT and are impersonating you to reset passwords and unenroll PingID to get the ability to access data including access to your financial aid. A faculty member had their direct deposit information changed and we almost lost thousands of dollars if we had not caught that. We now do not trust people on the phone as much because of this. We do not want that level of mistrust, so the OUIDPIN is our response to this. Starting Feb 26<sup>th</sup> you can go into One account settings and set your OUIDPIN. If you enroll in this you can avoid losing potentially crucial time calling OUIT to get issues resolved, such as if you need materials for your schoolwork.
