BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

Section 1: Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Search Committee Approval Revision Act of 2026.”

Section 2: Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to update Title III Chapter III-2 of the Code Annotated regarding approval of Presidential appointees for Search Committees.

Section 3: AMENDATORY: The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association Code Annotated Title VI is amended as follows. For the purposes of this bill, all items removed shall be denoted with a strikethrough (~~strikethrough~~). All items added shall be denoted with an underline (underline).

Title II- The Legislature

Appointments to Search Committees. Representatives to Search Committees shall be nominated by the SGA President and approved by the Chair of the Undergraduate Student Congress and the Chair of the Graduate Student Senate. ~~This can be approved through email or an in-person meeting.~~

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Procedure amending the Congress Bylaws to reflect the necessary changes to the responsibilities and duties of the Undergraduate Student Congress Vice Chair; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Vice Chair Revision Act of 2026”
- Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to amend the Oklahoma Student Government Association’s Undergraduate Student Congress’s Bylaws Section 4.2
- Section 3:** AMENDATORY: The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association’s Undergraduate Student Congress’s Bylaws Section 4.2 is amended as follows. For the purposes of this bill, all items removed shall be denoted with a ~~striketrough~~. All items added shall be denoted with an underline.

Section 4.2: CONGRESS VICE CHAIR

1. The Vice Chair is the second-highest ranking officer of Student Congress. The Vice Chair shall strive to facilitate the execution of Student Congress’ mission.
2. The Vice Chair shall advise and assist the Student Congress Chair on matters pertaining to the Congress.
3. The Vice Chair shall preside over general meetings and Executive Committee meetings in the absence of the Student Congress Chair and shall preside over the Committee of the Whole.
4. The Vice Chair shall organize and direct the orientation, as specified elsewhere in these Bylaws.
5. The Vice Chair shall write, organize, maintain, and update a Student Congress Handbook of resources as specified within these Bylaws.
6. The Vice Chair shall serve as the Associate Coordinator and shall work towards the successful integration of newly-appointed associates into Student Congress.
7. The Vice Chair shall be a voting ex-officio member of all committees. The Vice Chair shall attend no fewer than two (2) committee meetings per week , with the exception of the Executive Committee meeting, for the purpose of supporting committee operations, maintaining awareness of committee activities, and facilitating communication between committees and the

Student Congress leadership. The Vice Chair shall utilize information gathered from these meetings to inform the Chair and other relevant parties as necessary. The Vice Chair shall guide, advise, and assist the appointed Chairs of all established committees in their duties and responsibilities to the best of their ability. The Vice Chair shall report on committees as necessary to the Student Congress Chair.

8. The Vice Chair shall guide, advise, and assist the appointed Chairs of all established committees in their duties and responsibilities to the best of their ability.
9. The Vice Chair shall oversee matters of morale and personnel not otherwise specified within these Bylaws, including, but not limited to, logistics for food and transportation for Student Congress events.
10. The Vice Chair shall be required to complete no less than 8 hours of “office hours” per week in accordance with the monthly stipend awarded to the position. Should the stipend change, this section shall be amended to reflect the new stipend.
11. The Vice Chair shall be responsible for advising the Chair on all matters of communications and public relations on any of the Undergraduate Student Congress’s activities with or to the public.
12. The Vice Chair shall be responsible for ensuring that the Undergraduate Student Congress provides its members with at least two (2) Congressional Service opportunities occurring on at least two separate days of the week during the months wherein Congressional Service requirements exist. Additionally, the Vice Chair shall be responsible for tracking the completed monthly Constituent Service Point Requirements for all members of the Congressional Body and relay the completed tracking of the completed/missing points for each member of the body to the Congress Secretary.
13. The Vice Chair can request assistance from members of the body for matters regarding Communications, Public Relations, and event programming.
14. The Vice Chair shall be responsible for meeting with committee Vice Chairs monthly to receive insight on committee highlights and events for the social media page.

Section 4: This act shall become effective when passed in accordance with the SGA Constitution.

AS INTRODUCED

An Act of Legislation to amend election-related language in the Code Annotated; providing for short title, providing for codification, and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF OKLAHOMA STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION:

- Section 1:** Title: This act shall be known and may be cited as the “Spring 2026 Uncontested Elections Rework Act”.
- Section 2:** Purpose: The purpose of this act shall be to update the Code Annotated to rework the “Prefer not to vote” option on uncontested ballots, clarify its exact role, and expand the criteria for its inclusion. Additionally, a small change in wording will be made to clarify the proper deadline for infraction reporting.
- Section 3:** AMENDATORY: The University of Oklahoma Student Government Association Code Annotated Title VI Chapter 1, §8 and Title VI Chapter 5, §3 are amended as follows. For the purposes of this bill, all items removed shall be denoted with a strikethrough (~~strikethrough~~) and all items added shall be denoted with an underline (underline).

Chapter VI-1 General Provisions

1. **Uncontested Elections.** All positions for which one has filed for election, they must be placed on the ballot in the respective district, even if the position is uncontested. In an uncontested election, or elections where the number of candidates is less than the number of open positions, an additional option titled “No Candidate” shall be on the ballot. This option represents a direct negation against the candidate(s), not an abstention. The candidate shall win if they receive more votes than the ~~“prefer not to vote”~~ “No Candidate” option.

Chapter VI-5 Oversight and Enforcement

3. **Campaign Rules Infractions.** All complaints regarding violations of the SGA campaign rules shall be submitted in writing to the Election Commission within five (5) days of the incident which generated the complaint or within forty-eight (48) hours of the close following the closing of the polls – whichever is sooner. The

Election Commissioner shall notify all affected parties of any grievance and allow the accused twenty-four (24) hours to submit a written response or request an oral hearing. The Election Commission shall make a ruling within one (1) Class Day after the accused has either made a written statement, after the oral hearing, or if they failed to submit either within the twenty-four (24) hour period. The Election Commissioner may not impose any points without the aforementioned hearing process.

AS INTRODUCED

A Concurrent Resolution supporting Earth Day
sustainability initiatives at the University of Oklahoma;
and providing for distribution.

- Whereas: Earth Day, celebrated annually on April 22, was deliberately chosen in 1970 to maximize college student participation by falling between spring break and final examinations, highlighting the historic and continuing role of university communities, including the University of Oklahoma, in advancing environmental awareness and civic engagement;¹ and
- Whereas: The City of Norman holds historical significance in Oklahoma’s environmental movement, as the first Earth Day celebration in the state was organized in Norman in 1970 with involvement from the University of Oklahoma, establishing a longstanding connection between the University and environmental advocacy;² and
- Whereas: The City of Norman continues to commemorate Earth Day through an annual community-wide Earth Day Festival that promotes sustainability education, conservation practices, and civic engagement;³ and
- Whereas: Cleveland County, which includes the City of Norman, is monitored for environmental indicators such as ground-level ozone and particulate matter, emphasizing the continued importance of environmental awareness and mitigation efforts;⁴ and
- Whereas: Stormwater runoff, watershed protection, and solid waste management remain ongoing environmental priorities within the Norman community, underscoring the need for preventative sustainability practices;⁵ and

- Whereas: Institutions of higher education play a critical role in addressing environmental challenges through research, education, campus operations, and student engagement;⁶ and
- Whereas: A 2024 compilation of sustainability-related research at the University of Oklahoma identified more than 130 faculty members and researchers across numerous academic departments engaged in sustainability-focused scholarship, demonstrating the University's substantial institutional commitment to advancing environmental research and innovation;⁷ and
- Whereas: The transition toward sustainable and renewable energy sources, including solar and wind energy, is widely recognized as a critical strategy for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and promoting long-term environmental resilience, and institutions of higher education play a leadership role in advancing energy efficiency and sustainability initiatives;
- Whereas: The University of Oklahoma has demonstrated its commitment to sustainability through campus-wide recycling programs, environmental research initiatives, and operational sustainability efforts supported by the Office of Sustainability;⁸ and
- Whereas: Student organizations at the University of Oklahoma actively participate in environmental initiatives through campus cleanups, sustainability fairs, recycling advocacy, and educational programming;⁸ and
- Whereas: Increased institutional coordination of Earth Day initiatives can improve visibility, participation, and measurable environmental impact across campus; and
- Whereas: Collaboration between the Student Government Association, the Office of Sustainability, and student organizations such as Green Week, ESSA, and Botany Club can strengthen logistical planning, communication, and resource allocation for Earth Day programming;⁸ and
- Whereas: Strategic promotion of Earth Day events through official University communication channels such as OU Daily and OU Nightly can increase student awareness and engagement;⁹ and
- Whereas: Providing designated campus spaces for Earth Day events, educational booths, and volunteer activities can facilitate safe and accessible participation for students;¹⁰ and

Whereas: Coordinated waste reduction measures during Earth Day events, including recycling and waste diversion practices, can model sustainable event planning for future campus programming;⁸ and

Whereas: The use of non-biodegradable celebratory materials, including plastic-based confetti commonly used at graduation events and campus celebrations, can contribute to litter, stormwater pollution, and increased cleanup costs, and discouraging such materials supports cleaner campus spaces and environmentally responsible celebrations;¹¹ and

- Whereas: In 2001, the NSRVC coordinated the first National Sexual Assault Awareness Month; and
- Whereas: In 2009, Barack Obama became the first president to proclaim April as Sexual Assault Awareness Month; and¹⁴
- Whereas: Teal is the official color to represent Sexual Assault Awareness Month, which is used to symbolize solidarity and unity; and
- Whereas: April 1st being recognized as Sexual Assault Awareness Month allows communities to come together to raise awareness and stand by survivors; and¹⁵
- Whereas: Sexual Assault Awareness Month acts as a pillar to show survivors that they are not alone and prevent future victims in the future; and
- Whereas: Sexual Assault Awareness Month works as an empowerment for those who have been impacted; and
