2026 Submission Guidelines

OVERVIEW

The Standards of Excellence (SOE) initiative began in 2010 to renew focus on the core principles among all Greek organizations. This initiative was a response to a joint effort from staff, students, and the governing councils to build a process that would unify the goals and values of all chapters and to recognize the community for their varied contributions. SOE aims to set a minimum threshold for expectations of our campus fraternities and sororities while building pathways for excellence and development.

The result was 5 areas of excellence that represent not only the goals of chapters, but also Fraternity and Sorority Programs and Services (FSPS) and our commitment of providing **safe, meaningful, and transformative** experiences.

The areas of excellence include:

- Chapter Operations
- Education and Programming
- Academics and Scholarship
- Campus and Community Engagement
- Service and Philanthropic Giving

Each calendar year, chapters have the ability to earn 100 points. FSPS provides training, aid, resources, and guidance for all fraternal organizations to meet the SOE requirements. **All chapters at the University of Oklahoma are required to participate in the Standards of Excellence program to remain in Good Standing.**

Chapters that fall in the Unsatisfactory standing will work with FSPS to develop a performance improvement plan for the organization to meet the minimum standards. We will share SOE scores with inter/national organizations and local volunteers. SOE scores are also shared in the Greek Scorecards listed online.

**Point availability may depend on a variety of factors. FSPS will determine point availability and eligibility on case-by-case situations.*

Standards of Excellence submissions are due the final Friday of the fall semester at 5:00 PM.

STANDARD 1 | CHAPTER OPERATIONS

Total Points Possible: 25

Pre-Semester Paperwork (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for on-time submissions
 - 1 point for late submissions
 - 0 points for late submissions after 2 weeks
- **Due Date:** 5:00 PM on the first Friday of fall and spring semesters
- **How to Submit:** Complete organization re-registration process through OU Engage. Completed submissions include - chapter officer roster, minimum expectations covenant, event registration acknowledgement, and various housing forms (housed organizations only)

Roster Days (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Attend FSPS Roster Day (spring and fall) to confirm chapter membership roster
 - 1 point for Spring Roster Day
 - 1 point for Fall Roster Day
- **Due Dates:**
 - Spring 2026 Roster Day: March 10, 2026
 - Fall 2026 Roster Day: October 6, 2026
- **How to Submit:** Attend FSPS Roster Days in Student Life Office, update membership roster, all new members for current semester should be added by Roster Day

Membership Intake and Recruitment Paperwork (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for on-time submissions
 - 1 point for late submissions
 - 0 points for late submissions after 2 weeks or missing documents / required meeting
- **Due Date:** 2 weeks prior to beginning recruitment or membership intake activities, review FSPS Paperwork Guide for deadlines
- **How to Submit:** Email paperwork (MIR form and new member education plan) to Council Advisor. Review paperwork in mandated meeting with Council Advisor.

Financial Good Standing (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 1 point for financial good standing with governing council
 - 1 point for financial good standing with Fraternity and Sorority Programs and Services
- **Note:** Financial good standing is defined as being on a current payment plan or not having past-due debt with any entity.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Conduct & Judicial Standings (10 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Each chapter will start the calendar year with 10 points. Points will be deducted for violations chapters collect throughout the year. Up to 10 points can be deducted.
 - -1 point for each governing council policy violation
 - -3 points each Student Rights and Responsibilities Code violation (not including hazing)
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify in partnership with the Office of Student Conduct.
- **Note:** Once a new SOE cycle begins, the Conduct & Judicial Standing points will be reset, even if a chapter is still working through sanctions or outcomes from a previous case.

Membership Intake and Recruitment (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Conduct membership intake or recruitment at least once during the SOE cycle
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Chapter Planning / Leadership Development Meeting (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter President hosts a leadership development and/or planning meeting or retreat with chapter officers. This meeting should focus on goal setting and leadership development for the elected and/or appointed chapter officers.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload an agenda or minutes from this meeting using the “**S1 | Chapter Planning Meeting**” assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Chapter Representation (3 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Each chapter will start the calendar year with 3 points. Points will be deducted for violations chapters collect throughout the year.
 - -1 point for each reported negative representation of organization (some examples could include - profane language at chapter event, unsisterly or unbrotherly actions towards other organizations, etc.)
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Chapter Goals (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapters should set goals internally with their teams. These goals can be anything the chapter is working towards. Receive points for discussing these goals and progress in bi-semesterly Chapter Coaching meetings.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

STANDARD 2 | EDUCATION & PROGRAMMING

Total Points Possible: 19

FSPS Chapter President Leadership Retreats (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 1 point for the Chapter President or approved alternate in attendance at the Spring Retreat
 - 1 point for the President or approved alternate in attendance at the Fall Mini Retreat
- **Due Date:** Retreats are held the week before classes begin each semester
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Chapter Coaching Program (4 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** 1 point per meeting, Presidents are expected to attend 4 meetings annually. These meetings **do not** include required membership intake and recruitment meetings.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Mandated Educational Session Attendance (4 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Points are awarded based on the percent of new members that successfully complete their 3 mandated Greek life educational sessions:
 - 4 points for 100% of new members attending sessions
 - 3 points for 90 - 99% of new members attending sessions
 - 2 points for 80 - 89% of new members attending sessions
 - 1 points for 70 - 79% of new members attending sessions
 - 0 points for fewer than 70% of new members attending sessions
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify percentage with roster at the time of SOE submission.

FSPS Officer Training Institutes or Canvas Modules (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for 100% of officers completing available FSPS Officer Training Canvas modules or in-person Institutes
 - 1 point for 50% of officers completing available FSPS Officer Training Canvas modules or in-person Institutes
 - 0 points for less than 50% of chapter officers completing available modules or in-person Institutes
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify percentage of attendance with chapter officer roster at the time of SOE submission.

Organization Founder's Day (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter hosts or attends an event on or near the organization's Founder's Day
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of the event with a photo using the "**S2 | Organization Founder's Day**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Inter/National and/or Regional Conference or Meeting (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** At least one officer or member attended their own organization's inter/national and/or regional leadership conference, meeting, or other training relating to fraternity / sorority life.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a narrative of the event with a photo using the "**S2 | Inter/National or Regional Meeting**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Chapter Programming (5 points)

Headquarters Program (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Participate in or host any program sponsored by your inter/national headquarters or have your inter/national headquarters host a program with your chapter. Virtual programs can be counted for this area. This program should be geared toward the entire chapter.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of event, photo, and names of attendees using the "**S2 | HQ Program**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Risk Management and/or Safety Program (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** At least 50% of the chapter's membership attends a risk management or safety program.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of event, photo, and names of attendees using the "**S2 | Risk or Safety Program**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Program with Chapter from Same Governing Council (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter collaborates on a program/event with another fraternity/sorority organization from the same Greek governing council (i.e. Affiliate Circle, IFC, MGC, NPHC, Panhellenic). These programs must be alcohol and substance free.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of event, photo, and names of attendees using the "**S2 | Council Program**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Program with Chapter from a Different Governing Council (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter collaborates on a program/event with another fraternity/sorority organization from a different Greek governing council (i.e. Affiliate Circle, IFC, MGC, NPHC, Panhellenic). These programs must be alcohol and substance free.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of event, photo, and names of attendees using the **"S2 | Greek Program"** assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

Program with Registered Student Organization (RSO), Office, or Department (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter participates in or co-hosts a program or event in collaboration with a non-Greek Registered Student Organization (RSO), university office or on-campus department.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of event, photo, and names of attendees using the **"S2 | RSO/Department Program"** assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name.

- **Note:** Organizations are allowed to complete several of the areas outlined here with one event. For example, if a chapter hosted a risk management program with the Office of Advocacy and Education in collaboration with another organization from another council, both chapters would be awarded three points from the areas above with that single event provided they both submit documentation.

STANDARD 3 | ACADEMICS & SCHOLARSHIP

Total Points Possible: 5

Chapter GPA at or Above 2.75 (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for fall and spring chapter average GPA at or above 2.75
 - 1 point for either the fall or the spring chapter average GPA at or above 2.75
 - 0 points for neither fall or spring chapter average GPA at or above 2.75
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

New Member GPA at or Above 2.75 (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for fall and spring new member average GPA at or above 2.75
 - 1 point for either the fall or the spring new member average GPA at or above 2.75
 - 0 points for neither fall or spring new member average GPA at or above 2.75
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Chapter Academic Program (2 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Provide a written document that outlines a comprehensive academic or scholarship program. This program should describe individual member academic requirements, incentives, academic goals, and the job description of the academic officer for the chapter.
 - Inter/national programs used by organizations may serve as this documentation.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Combine all files into a single document and upload using the “**S3 | Academic Program**” assignment on Canvas. In the comment uploads, include your organization name.

STANDARD 4 | CAMPUS ENGAGEMENT

Total Points Possible: 9

Greek Preview Day (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter actively participates in Greek Preview Day programming. This can include tabling at the event, participating in house tours, volunteering, and more.
- **Due Date:** Greek Preview Day is held in March annually
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Council Meeting Attendance (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for 100% attendance at all governing council meetings
 - 1 point for 1 - 3 absences at all governing council meetings
 - 0 points for 4 or more absences at all governing council meetings
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify with Council Advisor and/or Council Executive Board

National Hazing Prevention Week (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapters participate in some way in National Hazing Prevention Week programming. Examples can include posting on social media, attending events, bringing in a speaker, etc.
- **Note:** Chapters may receive additional bonus opportunities for attending National Hazing Week Prevention throughout the week. Details will be sent prior to the week's activities.
- **Due Date:** National Hazing Prevention Week is held annually in late September
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify.

Campus Event Engagement (5 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** At least 50% of chapter members actively participated in 3 large-scale campus events. Examples of events include: OU Dance Marathon, Homecoming, Stompdawn, cultural food fairs / events, heritage month programs, Big Event, etc. Events must be non-FSPS events.
 - 5 points for 50% or more of chapter members participating in 3 campus events
 - 4 points for 50% or more of chapter members participating in 2 campus events
 - 3 points for fewer than 25% of members actively participating in 3 campus events
 - 2 points for fewer than 25% of members actively participating in 2 campus events
 - 1 point for any amount of members actively participating in 1 campus event
 - 0 points for no documentation and/or no participation in campus events
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Submit a brief narrative of each event, photo, and name(s) of attendee(s) using the **"S4 | Campus Event Engagement"** assignment on Canvas. Combine all files into a single document. Please clearly label each event within the document. Files should be organized by event with a list of attendees and photos underneath.

STANDARD 5 | SERVICE & PHILANTHROPY

Total Points Possible: 12

GivePulse (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter utilizes GivePulse for organization service hour tracking.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify chapter has service hours listed on GivePulse

Average of 10 Service Hours Per Member (3 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 3 points for averaging at least 10 service hours per member
 - 2 points for averaging at least 7 service hours per member
 - 1 points for averaging at least 4 service hours per member
 - 0 points for averaging 3 or fewer service hours per member
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will export organization service transcript from GivePulse for this SOE submission period. This is the number of service hours that will be shared in the FSPS Scorecards online. All chapters are **required** to utilize GivePulse to track service impacts.
- **Note:** FSPS will total the number of hours submitted for the SOE cycle and divide by the number of chapter members at the time of SOE submission to determine the average number of service hours per member. Only hours listed on GivePulse will count for SOE points.

Chapter Philanthropic Event (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapters will earn 2 points for hosting a philanthropic event and sharing proof of donation after the event.
- **Note:** Philanthropic events require a donation to be made to a nonprofit or charitable organization. Proof of donation is required to receive points. Donations can be monetary or goods. Food / clothing / book / other drives can be included.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Combine all files into a single document and upload using the “**S5 | Philanthropic Event**” assignment on Canvas. Document should include a photo and brief narrative of the event along with a breakdown of money/goods donated.

Philanthropic Giving (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapters will earn 2 points for sharing a full list of all philanthropic funds raised and places where money was donated. This list should include any funds raised for nonprofits, charitable causes, scholarships, and other programs.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a list of organizations or causes philanthropic funds were raised for and how much was donated using the “**S5 | Philanthropic Giving**” assignment on Canvas. Template provided [HERE](#).

Greek Service Week (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for members participating in two Greek Service Week programs
 - 1 point for members participating in one Greek Service Week program
 - 0 points for non participation
 - **Note:** There will be bonus opportunities provided during Greek Service Week for additional points.
- **Due Date:** Greek Service Week occurs in the fall semester annually
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify with Greek Service Week attendance lists and roster at the time of the program

The Big or Little Event (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapters earn 1 point for registering and having 1 or more members attend the Big or Little Event.
- **Due Date:** The Big Event is held in April annually, the Little Event is held each fall
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify with the Big Event Executive Team following the conclusion of the program.

BONUS

Total Points Possible: 28+

Greek Ambassador Program (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapters will earn 1 point for having member(s) represented as Greek Ambassadors.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

President's Cup (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter participates in the OU President's Cup application process.
- **Due Date:** President's Cup applications are due in March annually
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Additional Service or Philanthropic Event (1+ point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter hosts an additional service or philanthropy event in addition to any event(s) included from the S5 Service section. 1 point will be awarded for each event hosted.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a brief narrative of event, photo, and names of attendees using the "**BONUS | Additional Philanthropic Event(s)**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name. Combine all documents to a single file and label each event clearly.

United Way of Norman Support (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter actively supports the United Way of Norman or one of the [United Way partner agencies](#) in our local community.
- **Note:** Support to these communities can look like donation drives, philanthropic giving, service events, etc.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Provide a brief narrative of how your organization supported a United Way of Norman agency during this SOE cycle. Upload documentation through the "**BONUS | United Way**" assignment on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name. Combine all documentation to a single file.

OU Food Pantry Support (1 point)

- **How to Earn Points:** Chapter supports the OU Food Pantry in some way during this year's SOE cycle.
- **Note:** Support can look like donation drives, philanthropic giving, service events, etc.
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Provide a brief narrative of how your organization supported the OU Food Pantry during this SOE cycle. Upload documentation through the "**BONUS | OU Food Pantry**" assignment, on Canvas. In the upload comments, include your organization name. Combine all documentation to a single file.

Chapter GPA at or Above All Men's/Women's Average (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for fall and spring chapter average GPA at or above AMA/AWA
 - 1 point for fall or spring chapter average GPA at or above AMA/AWA
 - 0 points for neither fall or spring chapter average GPA at or above AMA/AWA
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

New Member GPA at or Above All Men's/Women's Average (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:**
 - 2 points for fall and spring new member average GPA at or above AMA/AWA
 - 1 point for fall or spring new member average GPA at or above AMA/AWA
 - 0 points for neither fall or spring chapter average GPA at or above AMA/AWA
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Chapter Coach will verify

Additional Programming (6 points)

Career Center Program / Interactions (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** 2 points for 50% of chapter membership interacting with the Career Center. Interactions can include members creating profiles on Handshake, attending career fairs, chapter hosting a resume workshop, etc.
 - 2 points for 50% or more of chapter interacting with the Career Center
 - 1 point for 25% - 49% of chapter interacting with the Career Center
 - 0 points for fewer than 25% of chapter interacting with the Career Center
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Gather documentation of Career Center interactions and upload using the **"BONUS | Career Center"** assignment on Canvas. Combine documentation to a single file.

Academic or Leadership Development Program (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** 2 points for 50% of chapter membership attending a university or fraternity/sorority sponsored academic or leadership development program. Examples can include (not are not limited to) Leader Summit, leadership speakers, lecture panels, leadership workshops, etc.
 - 2 points for 50% or more of chapter attending an academic or leadership program
 - 1 point for 25% - 49% of chapter attending an academic or leadership program
 - 0 points for fewer than 25% of chapter attending academic or leadership program
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Gather documentation of program hosted and upload to the **"BONUS | Academic or Leadership Program"** assignment on Canvas. Combine documentation to a single file before uploading.

Health & Safety Program (2 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** 2 points for 50% of chapter membership attending a university or fraternity/sorority sponsored health and safety program.

- 2 points for 50% or more of chapter attending a health and safety program
 - 1 point for 25% - 49% of chapter attending a health and safety program
 - 0 points for fewer than 25% of chapter attending a health and safety program
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Gather documentation of program hosted and upload to the **“BONUS | Health and Safety Program”** assignment on Canvas. Combine documentation to a single file before uploading.

Leadership & Campus Engagement (13 points)

Members Involved in Non-Chapter Activities and Programs (4 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** Members are involved in non-chapter activities and programs on campus. This can include involvement in other registered student organizations, on-campus jobs, scholarship programs, on-campus events, athletics, community programs, etc.
 - 4 points for 70% - 80% of chapter members involved in non-chapter activities
 - 3 points for 60% - 69% of chapter members involved in non-chapter activities
 - 2 points for 50% - 59% of chapter members involved in non-chapter activities
 - 1 point for 40% - 49% of chapter members involved in non-chapter activities
 - 0 points fewer than 30% of chapter members involved in non-chapter activities
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a list of member involvement in external programs and activities on campus. Chapters only need to list one activity per member, but are able to and encouraged to list all activities members are involved in outside the chapter. Use the **“BONUS | Member Involvement”** assignment on Canvas. Template provided [HERE](#).

Members Involved with University Orientation & Recruitment (4 points)

- **How to Earn Points:** 10% of members involved in Camp Crimson as Small Group Leaders or Orientation Guides, New Sooner Orientation, OU Bridge Programs, PTAs for Foundations, or the Office of Admissions and Recruitment.
 - 4 points for 10% or more of members involved in OU orientation and/or recruitment
 - 3 points 8% - 9% of members involved in OU orientation and/or recruitment
 - 2 points 6% - 7% of members involved in OU orientation and/or recruitment
 - 1 point 4% - 5% of members involved in OU orientation and/or recruitment
 - 0 points less than 4% of members involved in OU orientation and/or recruitment
- **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
- **How to Submit:** Upload a list of member involvement in university recruitment and orientation programs and activities on campus. Chapters only need to list one activity per member, but are able to and encouraged to list all activities members are involved in outside the chapter. Use the **“BONUS | University Orientation and Recruitment”** assignment on Canvas. Template provided [HERE](#).

Members Serving in Leadership Roles Outside the Chapter (5 points)*

- **How to Earn Points:** Members serve in leadership roles outside the chapter. These leadership roles include elected or appointed leadership roles in registered student organizations, scholarship programs, or community programs.

- 4 points for 40% - 50% of members involved in non-chapter leadership activities
 - 3 points for 30% - 39% of members involved in non-chapter leadership activities
 - 2 points for 20% - 29% of members involved in non-chapter leadership activities
 - 1 point for 10% - 19% of members involved in non-chapter leadership activities
 - 0 points fewer than 10% of members involved in non-chapter leadership activities
 - **Due Date:** At time of SOE submission
 - **How to Submit:** Upload a list of member leadership involvement in programs and activities on campus. Chapters only need to list one leadership role per member, but are able to and encouraged to list all activities members are involved in outside the chapter. Use the **"BONUS | Member Leadership Roles"** assignment on Canvas. Template provided [HERE](#).

Individual awards chapters can nominate for are listed below. Chapters are able to nominate one individual per award listed below:

Member of the Year

- *One member from each council, who best represents the ideas and values of fraternity and sorority life, will be recognized as member of the year. The award will consider the applicant's character, scholarship, Greek life involvement, and public service. Nominees should have been initiated for at least one semester.*

New Member of the Year

- *One new member from each council, who has made an immediate impact on their chapter, FSPS, and the campus community as a new member or new initiate.*

Advisor of the Year

- *This award will be given to a volunteer advisor that goes above and beyond to motivate, challenge, and support the collegiate officers and members. This person demonstrates their commitment by being present at chapter events and meetings, assists with organizational goal setting & transitions, and serves as a role model to the members and more.*

House Director of the Year

- *This award will be given to a fraternity or sorority house director who goes above and beyond to motivate, challenge, and support the undergraduate officers and members. This person demonstrates their commitment by being present at relevant chapter events and meetings, assists with organizational goal setting & transitions, and serves as a role model to the members and more.*

Outstanding Greek Senior

- *This award will be given to fraternity or sorority members who have made a lasting impact on their chapter or community. Community involvement, leadership, service, and academic impact should be discussed in the nomination form.*
- *One Outstanding Greek Senior will be selected for the Anona Adair Outstanding Greek Senior Award. This award is given to the most outstanding Greek senior from a given year's recipients.*

PRESIDENT'S CUP

2026 PRESIDENT'S CUP TIMEFRAME | JANUARY 1, 2026 - DECEMBER 31, 2026

The OU President's Cup recognizes the most outstanding Greek and Residence Hall groups achieving in the areas of scholarship, programming (Personal Development, Well-Being, and Community Impact), and community service. We have combined the President's Cup application into Standards of Excellence for easy access! Applying for the President's Cup is not required, but is a bonus point opportunity in Standards of Excellence.

- **Sororities** - There will be 1 winner (\$5,000) for chapters with 75 members and above and 1 winner (\$5,000) for chapters with 74 members and below.
- **Fraternities** - There will be 1 winner (\$5,000) for chapters with 75 members and above and 1 winner (\$5,000) for chapters with 74 members and below.
- From the Greek Chapter applications, there will be three Special Recognition Awards in each of the programming categories: Personal Development, Well-Being, and Community Impact.

President's Cup winners will be determined by 4 factors:

1. **PROGRAMMING INITIATIVES.** Chapters can upload descriptions of programs/events/ initiatives and photos
 - Use the various assignments under the President's Cup section on Canvas
 - **"PRESIDENTS CUP | Personal Development Programming Initiative"**
 - **"PRESIDENTS CUP | Well-Being Development Programming Initiative"**
 - **"PRESIDENTS CUP | Community Impact Programming Initiative"**
 - Assignments listed above have a breakdown of each programming area and items to include
 - Responses are limited to 500 words and 2 - 3 photos per program/event/initiative
2. **COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS.** Recorded via GivePulse. This category is based on the average number of community service hours per member, as well as the degree of impact.
3. **GRADE POINT AVERAGE.** Chapter grade reports will be pulled by FSPS.
4. **MEMBER LEADERSHIP LIST.** Chapters should upload this document via Canvas - find the template in the final item of the SOE Bonus points section.
