[b] Transfer students will need to meet the requirements of the first-year experience course [ENGR 1413] as well as ENGR 3511. The First Year Experience course (Core V) is waived, however, for students who earn an A.S Degree.

[c] ENGR 2002 Professional Responsibilities & Skills for Engineers may be taken in the summer session at OU between the second and third years.

[d] Electives are to be taken from a departmental list, please contact your OU advisor for more information.

[e] Per OU requirements, at least one course used to satisfy the general education requirements (Core IV) must be at the upper division level and outside of the student's major.

TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of OU and connect with an OU academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at OU as a transfer student <https://www.ou.edu/tulsa/apply>.
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations, you are about to earn your Associate's Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation @ <https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation>.
- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to OU (www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (<https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer>).

University of Oklahoma Program Notes and Information:

- Students must complete a minimum of 60 hours at OU or from a baccalaureate degree-granting institution to earn a bachelor's degree. This is an Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education policy.
- Students must complete a minimum of 30 hours at OU, fifteen hours must be upper-division (3000-& 4000-level) major courses. This is an Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education policy.
- Some OU courses are only offered once per year.

College Specific Program Notes and Information:

- At least one General Education category course must be at the Upper Division level (3000 or 4000 level) and outside a student's major.
- **College of Engineering Foreign Language Requirement:**
- Students can meet the OU foreign language requirement by completing two years of the same language in high school and having it posted on their high school transcript, or with a completed Associate in Science or Associate in Arts degree.

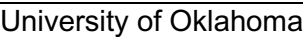
