OCCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- Consider Summer Courses: Summer courses at OCCC can help accelerate your time to transfer, and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses.

- **During Year Two at OCCC:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at OU-Norman as a transfer student https://www.ou.edu/admissions/apply/transfer.
- **Final Semester at OCCC:** Congratulations you are about to earn your Associate Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation at https://www.occc.edu/get/.
- **Transcripts**: After your final semester, submit an official OCCC transcript to OU with all grades earned posted https://www.occc.edu/records/transcripts/.
- Reverse Transfer: Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from OCCC may be eligible to complete their OCCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email OCCC Graduation Services to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program https://www.occc.edu/get/reverse transfer/.

OU Social Work Program Notes and Information:

- The College of Arts & Sciences requires 6 hours of Upper-Division General Education humanities outside
 of the major department.
- Students must complete a minimum of 60 hours at a four-year institution.
- Students must complete a minimum of 30 hours at OU, 15 of which must be upper-division major courses.

1. College of Arts & Sciences (CAS) Requirements:

- a) Humanities is defined as any course selected from Understanding Artistic Forms, Western Civilization or World Culture. These upper-division elective requirements must be from outside of the student's major.
- b) A natural physical science is any that comes from one of the following departments: AGSC, ASTR, CHEM, GEOG, GEOL, GPHY, METR, or PHYS.

2. College of Arts & Science Foreign Language Requirement:

- a) Students must complete a minimum of one credit hour at the intermediate (2000- course level) in any foreign language. This is waived for students who receive <u>CLEP credit</u> or successfully complete a <u>language skills</u> <u>assessment</u>. Students who have not completed this requirement may petition to have the requirement waived if they have completed at least 12 hours in a single foreign language. Otherwise, students must meet the requirement with either a combination of OCCC and OU coursework or entirely at OU.
- b) The following OCCC course sequences will meet the OU CAS 0-13 hour requirement for foreign language:
 - i. French: FREN 1115, 1225, & 2113
 - ii. Spanish: SPAN 1115, 1225, & 2113
 - iii. German: GRMN 1115, 1225 & 2113
- c) Students may use the CLEP exam to meet this requirement. In order to do so, the student must take the national CLEP exam and pass with a minimum score of:
 - i. French 59
 - ii. German 63
 - iii. Spanish 63
