TCC Milestones and Recommended Actions:

- **Consider Summer Courses:** Summer courses at TCC can help accelerate your time to transfer and help you stay on track. Talk to your advisor about planning summer courses. We recommend finishing Foreign Language II, III & IV at TCC to reduce credits at OU to 60. You can also complete them after finishing your associate degree at TCC and during your study at OU as transferred courses from TCC (in summer). Students who demonstrate fluency in a foreign language through a placement test may fulfill the language requirement for their degree, but they will not receive academic credit for this waiver.
- **During or After Year One at TCC:** Consider a campus tour of OU-Tulsa and connect with an OU-Tulsa academic advisor, to ensure you are on track to transfer. Your TCC academic advisor can assist in planning these actions.
- **During Year Two at TCC:** During or right after semester three coursework, apply for admission at OU-Tulsa as a transfer student <https://www.ou.edu/tulsa/apply>.
- **Final Semester at TCC:** Congratulations, you are about to earn your Associate Degree! Be sure to apply for graduation @ <https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation>.
- **Transcripts:** After your final semester, submit an official TCC transcript to OU (www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/student-records/requesting-and-submitting-transcripts).
- **Reverse Transfer:** Students who transfer to a university before completing an associate degree and who have earned at least 15 credit hours from TCC may be eligible to complete their TCC degree through Reverse Transfer. Email reversetransfer@tulsacc.edu to see if you qualify for a degree through the Reverse Transfer program (<https://www.tulsacc.edu/student-resources/graduation/reverse-transfer>).
