

RECLASSIFICATION ELIMINATES NON-RESIDENT TUITION CHARGES.

You may be eligible for reclassification to Resident student status. This does not change your legal state of residence.

2. A Certificate of Eligibility for Ch 30, 33, or 35 VA Benefits

- OR-

A Chapter 31 Veterans Readiness & Employment (VR&E) Purchase Order

- OR -

A DD-214 which meets the following conditions:

- Oklahoma is the Sponsor's Home of Record
- Active duty period must have been 90 days or more
